Extra care & attention required for tenants.




The top 4 concerns from Property

What impact do you think the following changes will have on the industry?




Public perception of the industry

71% don't see it changing in the future.


What do you believe the public perception of the residential property management industry is?


Most important skills


Everything is important but communication skills stand out as the highest of importance.



Performance against these skills


There is a big gap between what **Property Managers** see as important skills vs how we see the industry performing
